Subject: Close out Contract AM-783-17 for the 2017-2018 Sinkhole Filling AML Project, Case No. AM-17-84

On May 31, 2017, the Commission entered into Contract No. AM-783-17 with Pleasant and Sons Construction of Greenville, KY, for the 2017-18 Sinkhole Filling County AML Project. This two-year project involved filling dangerous sinkholes caused by the collapse of underground mine workings. The AML Division recommends this contract be closed.

Work began on July 21, 2017 and was completed on November 9, 2018. Approximately 340 dangerous sinkholes were filled at sites near Beulah, Bowman, Garrison, Hanks, Heil, New Leipzig, New Salem, Noonan, Richardton, Wilton and Zenith.

The contract amount was \$199,999.96. One change order was issued to increase sinkhole filling and tillage/seeding. The total amount paid to Pleasant and Sons under this contract was \$209,714, or about 5% over the contract amount. Bill Dodd supervised this project and all work was completed satisfactorily. The contractor certified all employees, subcontractors and suppliers used for fulfilling terms of the contract have been paid. The final invoice has been paid to Pleasant and Sons.

Attached is a motion for the December 6, 2018, Commission Meeting to close out Contract AM-783-17 with Pleasant and Sons Construction.
