As a follow up to our phone conversation last week I spoke with the following Department Heads in regards to permitting needed for the proposed CENEX pipeline routing.

- <!--[if !supportLists]-->• <!--[endif]-->Dan Jonasson, Public Works Director was busy but gave me the wellhead protection ordinance. I reviewed the ordinance and found the location of the CENEX tank farm, which is the terminus for the proposed pipeline to be outside of the Well Head Protection Zone. The WHPZ is on the other side of Highway 2/52.
