I decided to do a deep dive into this project given the sites we missed and uncovered another one not reported. I apologize for the oversights of my organization prior to my arrival but please know I will ensure this does not happen on this or any future projects.

During my review I uncovered a site 32MN1511 that was not reported on. No construction work has occurred at this site and therefore the project has not impacted the site. The enclosed memo discusses our proposed reroute to the northeast avoiding the site by 50-feet. I am hopefully you can

squeeze this review in with the other memo you are reviewing tomorrow.
