**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**June 16, 2017**

On **March 8, 2017**, Otter Tail Power Company, an electric public utility, filed an application under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-03 to extend service to ND Soybean Processors, LLC at a location in Stutsman County, ND.

Submitted with the application was a statement by ND Soybean Processors, LLC that it desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

**The NE 1/4 of Section 28, Twp 140N, R 77W, Stutsman County,  
North Dakota**

On **March 15, 2017**, the Public Service Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing with the response date for comments being **April 11, 2017**.

It was later discovered that the legal description on Otter Tail Power Company's Application for Permanent Authority and the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing issued March 15, 2017 was incorrect.

On **June 5, 2017**, Otter Tail Power Company filed a clarification and correction of the legal description of the location, along with a Statement of Customer for the proposed ND Soybean Processors, LLC facility.

Submitted with the clarification and correction filing was a statement by ND Soybean Processors, LLC that it desires electric service to be provided by the applicant.



North Dakota**


Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.
