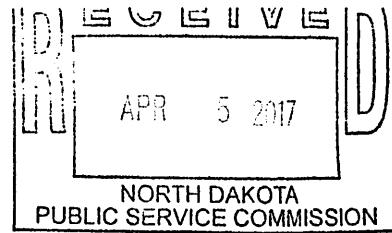

 MDU will bore under Hwy 10, with underground primary to feed a new house on the south side of Hwy 10, approximately 500 feet from existing underground primary cable.

The projects estimated cost will be \$11,000 with a two year revenue of \$2,000.
 The customer, Jarrad Larson, will have a construction contribution of around \$9,000.
