NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR CONSOLIDATED HEARING

May 10, 2017

On May 28, 2014, in Case No. PU-13-835, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 38 to Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation (Whiting) designating 35 acres for the construction, operation and maintenance of a 110 million cubic feet per day gas processing plant (the Robinson Lake Gas Plant) in Mountrail County, North Dakota.

On October 19, 2011, in Case No. PU-11-102, the Commission issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 124 and Route Permit Number 133 to Whiting for the construction, operation and maintenance of a 6.8-mile, 8-inch pipeline in Billings and Stark Counties, North Dakota for the transmission of crude oil.

On March 29, 2017, Whiting and QEP Field Services, LLC (QEP) filed a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 38 to QEP, Case No. PU-17-117.

On April 21, 2017, Whiting and QEP filed a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 124 and Route Permit Number 133 to QEP, Case No. PU-17-157.

The issues to be considered are whether QEP agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 38, Certificate No. 124, and Permit #133 issued to Whiting, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must**


be received by June 23, 2017. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
