**ORDER**

**Preliminary Statement**

On **May 18, 2017**, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (MDU), filed a request for approval of revisions to its natural gas tariff that would allow it to charge for the installation of an Excess Flow Valve (EFV) for existing service lines.

On **June 29, 2017**, the Commission discussed this matter with MDU and Commission staff during an informal hearing.

**Discussion**

During the June 29, 2017 informal hearing the following was offered and accepted into the record.

MDU is a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc., a Delaware corporation, authorized to provide public utility service in North Dakota under the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission.


MDU's proposed tariff revisions would allow it to charge customers who request an EFV be added to their service line the actual costs for the installation of that EFV.

**Order**


The Commission orders:
