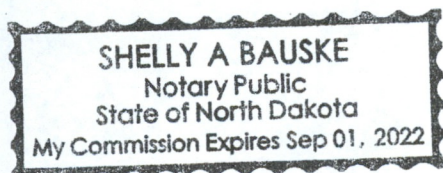

ORDER ON PROTECTION OF INFORMATION

February 19, 2020

Preliminary Statement

November 29, 2019, Norther States Power Company filed an Application for Protection of Information to protect certain information in the captioned case.

On December 10, 2019, staff reviewed the request of the Company for protection of information.

Discussion

The information for which the Company seeks protection under N.D.C.C. 47-25.1-01(4), 44-04-18.4, and N.D. Admin. Code chapter 69-02-09 includes their economic development model, company related marginal costs and proposed investments to serve potential customers, and estimates of customer billing determinants and related bill calculations.

The confidentiality of this information has been maintained by the Company. The information is not disclosed to the public or to persons other than employees or authorized agents who need to know the information to fulfill their responsibilities in connection with the subject matter of the information, would derive economic value to competitors, and damage the bidding process which ultimately would hurt consumers.

The Company has requested that this, and similar types of this information, be treated as trade secret.

North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-02-09-03 provides "the commission staff shall examine the information and application, and file and serve a response that includes a recommendation on whether the information qualifies for protection."

Staff believes that the application satisfies the requirements of the law, which allows the Commission to grant protection of information in this proceeding.


The Commission concludes the Company's application satisfies the requirements of the North Dakota Century Code for protection of the information, which is the subject of this request.


Order
