NOTICE OF NONCOMPLIANCE

Project: Foxtail Wind, LLC
Foxtail Wind Energy Center – Dickey County
Case No. PU-17-284

The Commission's January 31, 2018, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in Case No. PU-17-284 issued Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 53 to Foxtail Wind, LLC designating a location for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Project.

As-built GIS data

The Certification to Order Provisions paragraph 34 (Certification) attached to and made part of the Order requires that the Company provide the Commission with both an electronic and a paper copy of the site approved by the Commission and the facility design specifications for the construction of the energy conversion facility showing the location of the energy conversion facility as built, and will provide this information within 3 months of the completion of the construction. The Certification requires that the Company also provide an electronic version of the site approved by the Commission and the facility design specifications for the construction of the energy conversion facility showing the location of the energy conversion facility as built that can be imported into ESRI GIS mapping software within 3 months of the completion of the construction.

It appears the Company has filed an electronic (pdf) and a paper copy of the as-approved corridor and the as-built route, but has not filed with the Commission the electronic version of the site approved by the Commission and the facility design specifications for the construction of the energy conversion facility showing the location of the energy conversion facility as built that can be imported into ESRI GIS mapping software.

Staff requests that the GIS mapping data be filed with the Public Service Commission by February 11, 2022, to avoid further action due to noncompliance.
