Variance Permit Request Received June 29, 2017:

To operate two portable pitless scales in commerce.

Temporary Variance Permit Conditions:

- Each scale will not be used beyond its 120,000 lb. overall capacity;
- During the temporary variance period, each scale must maintain acceptance tolerance;
- Once every three months from the date of being placed into service by a registered service company, each scale must be retested and adjusted by a registered service company. The three-month test reports must be submitted to the Commission;
- Within 30 days from the date of each scale being placed into service by a registered service company, a copy of the scale ticket for each scale must be filed with the Commission;
- The service company test reports must include both the "as found" and "as left" readings;

- Except for the specific variance granted by Permit Numbers 520 and 521, each scale must be operated according to all applicable North Dakota Laws and Rules;
- The enclosed variance permit must be posted near the designated scale in a place clearly visible to the public; and
- Failure to comply with the variance permit conditions may result in revocation.

We must also notify you that a portable pitless scale that is in a location for **6 months or more** must meet approach requirements found in North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-10-02-09 and NIST Handbook 44 UR.2.6.1 as follows:

- on the entrance and exit ends of the vehicle scale there shall be a straight approach as follows:
 - the width at least the width of the platform,
 - the length of twelve feet or a distance equal to one-third of deck length, whichever is greater, beginning in a level plane with the surface of the scale deck, and
 - the first twelve feet of the straight approach from the scale must be of metal or concrete to insure that this portion remains smooth and level and in the same plane as the platform. Metal grating must be of sufficient strength to withstand all loads equal to the concentrated load capacity of the scale. Any slope of the remaining portion of the straight approach away from the scale deck may not exceed one-third inch [8.47 millimeters] per foot [30.48 centimeters].
 - any slope in any remaining portion of approaches beyond the straight approach shall ensure ease of vehicle access, ease for testing purposes, and drainage away from the scale.
