
This is to inform you that at the February 20, 2018 meeting, the McKenzie County Board of Commissioners approved the request for the zone change. Property located W ½ NE ¼ of Sec 21, T 149 N, R 98W, parcel number is 630010300.

The following conditions are placed upon the Conditional Use Permit:

1. The applicant shall design the storm water and culvert system to convey a 25 year event.
2. The applicant shall adhere to noxious weed containment plan as submitted to the County Weed Control Officer.
3. The applicant shall maintain a site free of garbage, from within the site, or from outside sources, during construction and operation.
4. The applicant shall provide the County Planning Department with all State and Federal approvals, along with any violations relating to the project.
5. The applicant shall continually control dust and tracking during construction and operation on site to not track or create a nuisance to the neighboring property owners and the traveling public.
6. The applicant shall donate for the county to pave County Road 37, per signed agreement.

7. This conditional use permit will remain in force, but can be terminated if there are violations or changes of the approved conditions. Any violation can cause this CUP to be placed before the County Commission for revocation.
  
8. The applicant shall provide a bond equaling 150% of an engineer's estimate to remove above-ground structures if necessary and reclaim the site to a pre-development setting. The pipeline itself does not need to be covered by the bond. The estimate shall be provided as part of the application. The bond shall be in favor of McKenzie County, and turned in to the McKenzie County Planning Department thirty (30) days after County Commission approval.
