**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INPUT SESSIONS AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**February 27, 2018**

On November 2, 2017, Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed a Notice for Change in Rates for Electric Service under North Dakota Century Code Section 49-05-05 and North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-09-02-01. Otter Tail proposes a \$13.14 million or 8.72 percent increase in its annual North Dakota electric revenues. The proposed rates would affect Otter Tail's service to all of its retail electric customers in the State of North Dakota. Interim rates subject to refund were approved on December 20, 2017 and February 27, 2018.

A **Public Input Session** will be held via interactive television on **April 3, 2018 at 5 p.m. CDT** at locations set forth below. Members of the public are invited to appear and participate in the informal discussion. The session is not considered part of the technical hearing and the discussion at the session will not become part of the evidence reviewed by the Commission in making its decision. The discussion will, however, aid the Commission and its staff in identifying areas of concern to members of the public and help customers better understand Otter Tail's request. 
The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. What is the value of Otter Tail's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
2. What is Otter Tail's rate of return on its property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
3. What is a just and reasonable rate of return on Otter Tail's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
4. What rates and charges are necessary to provide a just and reasonable rate of return on Otter Tail's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
5. Are Otter Tail's proposed rate schedules designed in such a manner that they result in a basis of charge to its customers that is just and reasonable without discrimination?

**Petitions to Intervene** are governed by N.D. Administrative Code Chapter 69-02-02. However, the Commission encourages anyone wishing to become a party to this proceeding to file a Petition to Intervene as early in the process as possible to allow, if granted intervener status, full participation in prehearing filings and other actions. Consequently, anyone wishing to become a party should file a Petition to Intervene **by April 20, 2018**. A Petition to Intervene does not need to be filed to participate in the Public Input Session.
