Good morning Dean,

I wanted to clarify to ensure we both have the same understanding – as the Mott Grain has indicated once the 3-phase service is installed, they also desire to convert existing load that is running on phase converters to the utility three phase service in addition to the initial load. As it appears that the remaining single phase load would be minimal, the customer also indicated the preference that all load on the site be served by MDU to avoid confusion or other issues.

I have not been to the site personally, but my initial understanding was that there was sufficient separation to allow both services to safely exist, and that MDU was only providing 3-phase service to the new load. Based on what I've heard now, I wanted to ensure that Slope does not have objections to MDU serving both new and existing load at this location.
