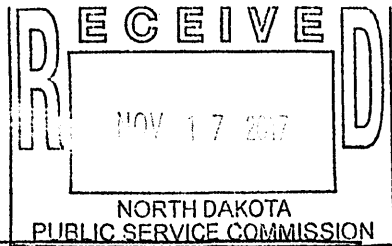
Please submit your formal application for permanent authority as soon as possible so we may work on finalizing this request.
