At the April 12, 2018 hearing for the above-referenced matter, the Commission inquired about H2S collection. The following information is provided in response to the Commission's inquiry.

The ONEOK Lonesome Creek facility has an inlet specification on H2S of 4 parts per million (ppm). If an H2S level on the outlet of a compressor station leading to Lonesome Creek exceeds the specification, the gathering line will be shut down. Once ONEOK identifies the producer of the high H2S, they will lock out the source well, purge and clear the line to remove the high H2S, and keep the well locked out until the producers correct the issue.
