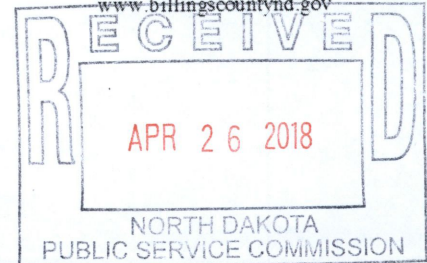

RE: Andeavor Field Services, LLC - NGL Pipeline Siting Application Notice (PU-18-72)

Thank you for the notices for the proposed Andeavor Field Services, LLC 8" & 6" NGL pipelines to be constructed through McKenzie, Billings, and Stark counties.

Since 1975, Billings County has issued special county use permits to pipelines in order to ensure that no undue damage or injury to county roads, bridges, rights-of-way, easements, structures or other property, whether real or personal, public or private occurs. Whenever a pipeline crosses a county road or section line right-of-way, a pipeline permit is required. Applications are administered through the zoning department and are reviewed by the county highway superintendent and a recommendation is submitted to the board of county commissioners to approve, approve with conditions, or deny.

Billings County is aware of this project and Andeavor Field Services, LLC has submitted and been approved for the following permits as required by the county:

- Pipeline Permit #4405 was issued by the Billings County Commission on March 9, 2018. This application is for the 22 mile, 8" line that is referenced as the "South Segment" in the Consolidated Application to the PSC.
- Pipeline Permit #4406 was issued by the Billings County Commission on March 9, 2018. This application is for the 6" line that is referenced as the "Product Transfer Segment" in the Consolidated Application to the PSC.
