Dear Mr. Johnson:

This is a follow-up to our recent telephone conversation relative to a Notice of Noncompliance dated January 13, 2020 concerning the above-captioned matter. As you know, the Notice of Noncompliance set forth a number of alleged deficiencies as determined by Wenck Associates, Inc. regarding the Andeavor NGL Pipeline Project.

In accordance with the Notice of Noncompliance, Andeavor Field Services LLC has filed with the Commission the following:

1. Copy of the permit application and permit approval from Billings County for the Transfer Line Segment;
2. Copy of its ND Department of Health Permit to Discharge Hydrostatic Test Water;
3. Copies of permits from the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, to cross federal-aid highways;
4. Copy of its Utility Occupancy Permit from the ND Department of Transportation;
5. Copy of its Billings County Conditional Use/Pipeline Permit; and
6. Copy of its McKenzie County Conditional Use/Pipeline Permit.

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Follow-up response to 13 Jan. 2020 Notice Of Noncompliance

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The Notice of Noncompliance alleges that Andeavor also needs to file the following:

1. Certifications and supporting documentation for four (4) route adjustments;
2. Documentation that McKenzie County approved construction of the pipeline in Section 22, Township 149 North, Range 98 West;
3. That Andeavor kept the Commission and the Commission's third-party construction inspector updated on construction on a monthly basis.

Andeavor is working on obtaining these additional items for submission to the Commission. Also, as requested by the Commission, Andeavor is working on the preparation of a proposed consent decree to submit to the Commission so this matter can be brought to a close.
