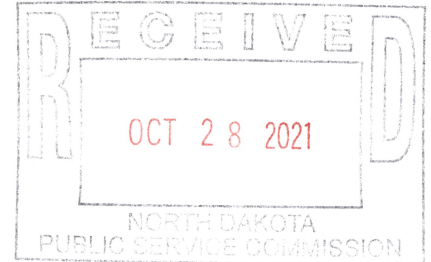

Dear Mr. Fahn:

On September 25, 2020, the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued a Notice of Noncompliance – Supplement in the above-referenced case (“Notice”). The Notice alleges that certain portions of the as-built route do not coincide with the route designated by the Commission’s June 13, 2018 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Order”). Andeavor Field Services LLC (“Andeavor”) has reviewed the as-built maps and has submitted certifications regarding several of the more significant route adjustments. However, based on the large number of minor route deviations alleged in the Notice, it seems appropriate that Andeavor submit an application to amend the Commission’s Order dated June 13, 2018 to provide that the current location of the pipeline, as shown in the as-built drawings, be designated as the route; with the corridor designated as overlapping the route an equal distance on either side of the center line of the as-built pipeline. Assuming the application for an amended order is approved, as set forth herein, this will resolve the matters raised in the Commission’s Notice. This approval will also provide the most expedient manner in which to resolve the many minor route adjustments and put the route in the center of the corridor.
