CERTIFICATION RELATING TO N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a)

Pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a), the undersigned, David Roensch, Vice-President – Natural Gas Gathering and Processing Operations, a representative of ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C. (“ONEOK”), with the authority to bind ONEOK to the following, hereby certifies as follows:

1. In an order dated May 18, 2011, in the above-captioned matter (“Order”), the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 22 for the construction, operation and maintenance of two 100 million standard cubic foot per day (“MMscfd”) gas processing plants (the “Plants”). *See* PU-11-658 (reissuing Certificate 22) to ONEOK).

2. The Plants process associated Bakken natural gas from oil production wells connected to ONEOK’s gathering system. “Construction of the Plants [included] underground piping, above ground piping, and above ground gas processing facilities.” Docket No. 27, Exhibit 2 - Application, Section 1, Pg. 2.

3. ONEOK hereby provides the Commission with written notice of its intent to construct additional facilities wholly within the existing site of the Plants as approved by the Commission’s Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 22. Specifically, ONEOK proposes to install 1,020 feet of piping within the Plants (“Improvement”). Attached to this Certification and incorporated herein, are maps designating the scope and location of the Improvement (“Exhibit A”). The Improvement to the Plants facilitates future natural gas liquids delivery out of the Plants. The Improvement consists of 8-foot deep piping that is designed to move natural gas liquids from the termination of the Cherry Creek Pipeline to the ONEOK Bakken Pipeline’s Stateline Lateral. The Improvement will not increase the permitted capacity of the Plants. This Certification is for the construction of the Improvement only. ONEOK will obtain necessary approvals from the Commission prior to filling or operating the Improvement.

4. Activities for the Improvement will occur within ONEOK’s fenced facilities, which are wholly within the geographic location for which ONEOK previously obtained a site certificate as designated in the Order. *See* N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a).

5. Construction for the Improvement is for similar facilities as approved in the Commission's Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 40. *See* N.D.C.C. 49.22.1-01(3)(a)(1); *see e.g.* Docket No. 27, Exhibit 2 - Application, Section 1, Pg. 2.

6. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. §49-22.1-01(3)(a)(4),

- a. The Improvement will not affect any known exclusion or avoidance area;
- b. The activities are for construction of an improvement to the existing Plant; and,
- c. ONEOK will continue to comply with the Order issued in this case and will continue to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and rules.

7. The Improvement was referenced within the Cherry Creek Lateral Pipeline Conversion Project Application, PU-17-483 ("Cherry Creek Application"), which was scheduled for hearing March 6, 2018. Due to severe weather, the Commission postponed the hearing.

8. While the Improvement was referenced within the Cherry Creek Application, the Improvement is wholly within the scope of ONEOK's Certificate for the Plants. The Improvement is for in-facility piping as previously approved by the Commission's Order in the above-referenced matter therefore, construction of the Improvement is proper under, and is within the scope of, the Plants' Certificate.

9. Based on the circumstances of this situation, ONEOK made a good-faith representation made to Commission Staff that it would submit a certification to the Commission prior to commencing construction of the Improvement.

10. For the reasons discussed herein, and because completion of the Improvement will increase take away capacity and aide in reduced flaring caused by increased production, ONEOK respectfully requests Commission approval to commence in-facility construction for the Improvement in order to aide in maintaining the project schedule.

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6. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. §49-22.1-01(3)(a)(4),



9. Based on the circumstances of this situation, ONEOK made a good-faith representation to Commission Staff that it would submit a certification to the Commission prior to commencing construction of the Improvement.

10. For the reasons discussed herein, and because completion of the Improvement will increase take away capacity and aide in reduced flaring caused by increased production, ONEOK respectfully requests Commission approval to commence in-facility construction for the Improvement in order to aide in maintaining the project schedule.



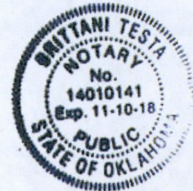
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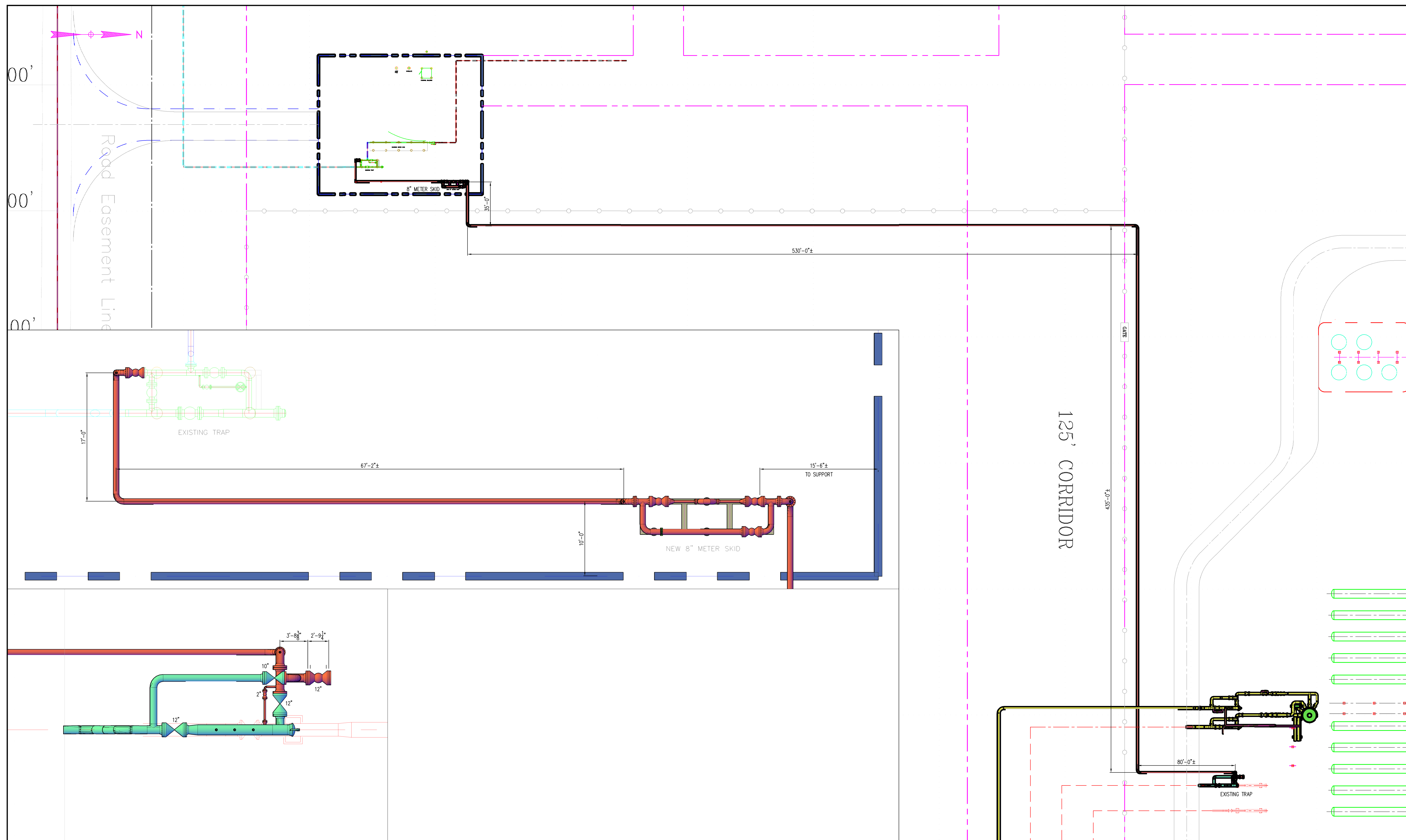
