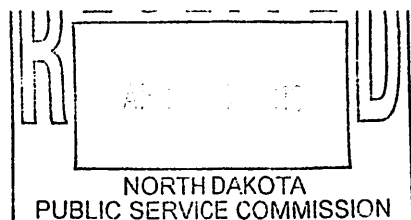

LEE DICK CONTACTED OTTER TAIL POWER COMPANY (OTP) TO PROVIDE 3-PHASE SERVICE TO HIS BIN SITE AT HIS FARMSTEAD. NORTHERN PLAINS ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE (NPEC) IS CURRENTLY PROVIDING 1-PHASE SERVICE TO THE FARMSTEAD AND BIN SITE. FROM MR DICK'S INFORMATION, NPEC IS APPROXIMATELY 4.5 MILES AWAY WITH 3-PHASE. OTP HAS A 3-PHASE LINE APPROXIMATELY 1,000 FT NORTH OF HIS DRIVEWAY. OTP WOULD INSTALL AN UNDERGROUND 3-PHASE LINE TO SERVE THE GRAIN HANDLING SITE ONLY. THE GRAIN HANDLING SITE IS CURRENTLY METERED SEPARATELY FROM THE FARMSTEAD. I HAVE CONTACTED SETH SYVERSON, NPEC, ABOUT THIS REQUEST.
