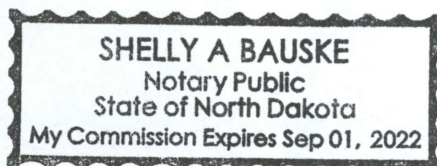


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

July 9, 2018

On June 26, 2018, BakkenLink Pipeline LLC (BakkenLink) filed an application to cancel Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Number 5834 for the construction and operation of its common carrier (crude petroleum) pipeline in Billings, Stark, and McKenzie Counties, North Dakota. On July 6, 2018, BakkenLink filed an application to replace and substitute for the June 26, 2018 filing asking to cancel or otherwise abandon Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Number 5834.

The Certificate, granted by the Commission on September 17, 2014, in Case No. PU-13-901, was for an existing and already constructed south 95 miles of the BakkenLink Project, and for a north 37 miles of the BakkenLink Project subject to federal approvals required for construction. The north 37 miles is not constructed.

The issue in this proceeding is whether BakkenLink should be permitted to abandon its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the BakkenLink Project.


Those interested are invited to comment in writing on the application in Case No. PU-18-217. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by August 3, 2018.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
