

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On February 26, 2019, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 58 (Certificate) designating a site, to Harmony Solar ND, LLC (Harmony) for the construction, operation and maintenance of a solar energy conversion facility in Cass County, North Dakota.

On July 31, 2024, Harmony filed with the Commission an Application for an Order of Continuing Suitability, certifying that the site designated on February 26, 2019, continues to meet the conditions upon which the Certificate was issued. Harmony intends to begin construction of the project as early as the second quarter of 2025 and no later than the second quarter of 2027.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:


1. Whether the site continues to meet the evaluation requirements and conditions under which the Certificate was issued?
2. If so, during what time period should construction be authorized to begin?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by October 11, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
