**UPDATED AFFIDAVIT OF RACHEL GRANNEMAN IN SUPPORT OF  
ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE* ON APPEAL**

COMES NOW Rachel Granneman updating her affidavit pursuant to North Dakota Admission to Practice Rule 3(A)(5) in order to appear as counsel for the Environmental Law & Policy Center in the above captioned case, which is an appeal of the decision in a North Dakota Public Service Commission proceeding in which she was previously admitted *pro hac vice*.

Pursuant to North Dakota Admission to Practice Rule 3(A)(1)(b), Ms. Granneman states as follows:

1. I am an attorney at the Environmental Law & Policy Center. I have been admitted to the Illinois State Bar for five years, the Northern District of Illinois for four years, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit for one year, and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit as of this year. I am of good standing in each of these jurisdictions.
2. I am not subject to any disciplinary proceedings in any jurisdiction.
3. I am not under any restriction or probation in the practice of law in any jurisdiction in which I am licensed.
4. I am not now nor have I ever been suspended from practicing law.

5. I appeared *pro hac vice* in association with a Complaint filed before the North Dakota Public Service Commission, titled *Environmental Law & Policy Center and Dakota Resource Council v. Meridian Energy Group, Inc.*, Docket No. PU-18-223. This case is an appeal of the Public Service Commission's decision in that case.

I am currently appearing *pro hac vice* before the North Dakota District Court in the County of Stark, in the proceeding titled *National Parks Conservation Association, Environmental Law & Policy Center, and Dakota Resource Council v. North Dakota Department of Health and Meridian Energy Group, Inc.*, Civil No. 45-2018-CV-00680.
