The commission discussed the Recommended Order received from the Administrative Law Judge. Commissioner Christmann suggested an edit to a sentence to correct an erroneous statement, and Counsel suggested an edit to a sentence to more accurately portray the commission's authority.

Commissioners discussed their options and staff advised them of the most recent filing and the estimated time by which the ALJ could rule on the filing. No further plans were made for a future work session, but that is still a possibility given the issues pending.

Staff advised that in the meantime, staff will work on form and format for a future commission decision on the Recommend Order.
