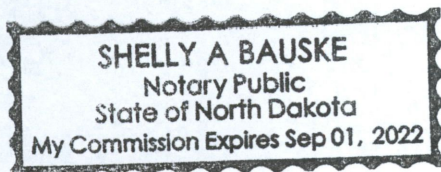

NOTICE OF FILINGS AND PUBLIC HEARING

August 22, 2018

A public hearing on the applications for Case No. PU-18-277 is scheduled for **September 27, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. Central Time, at Teddy's Residential Suites, 113 9th Ave SW, Watford City, North Dakota 58854.**

Hiland Partners Holdings LLC (Hiland) has filed applications for a certificate of site compatibility concerning the location for the expansion of an existing gas processing facility, the Roosevelt Gas Plant (Plant), in McKenzie County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The nameplate processing capacity of the Plant will expand from 60 million standard cubic feet per day (MMSCFD) to 260 MMSCFD. The primary products at the Plant are residue gas and natural gas liquids.

Hiland has also filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22.1-05, 49-22.1-06, and 49-22.1-10; and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02 requiring separate hearings on such applications and setting a six-month period for designation of a site.

The issues in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues in the applications for a certificate of site compatibility:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?

3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?


If determined that a waiver of procedures and time schedules is appropriate, the Commission may consider the application for a corridor certificate and route permit without further notice.

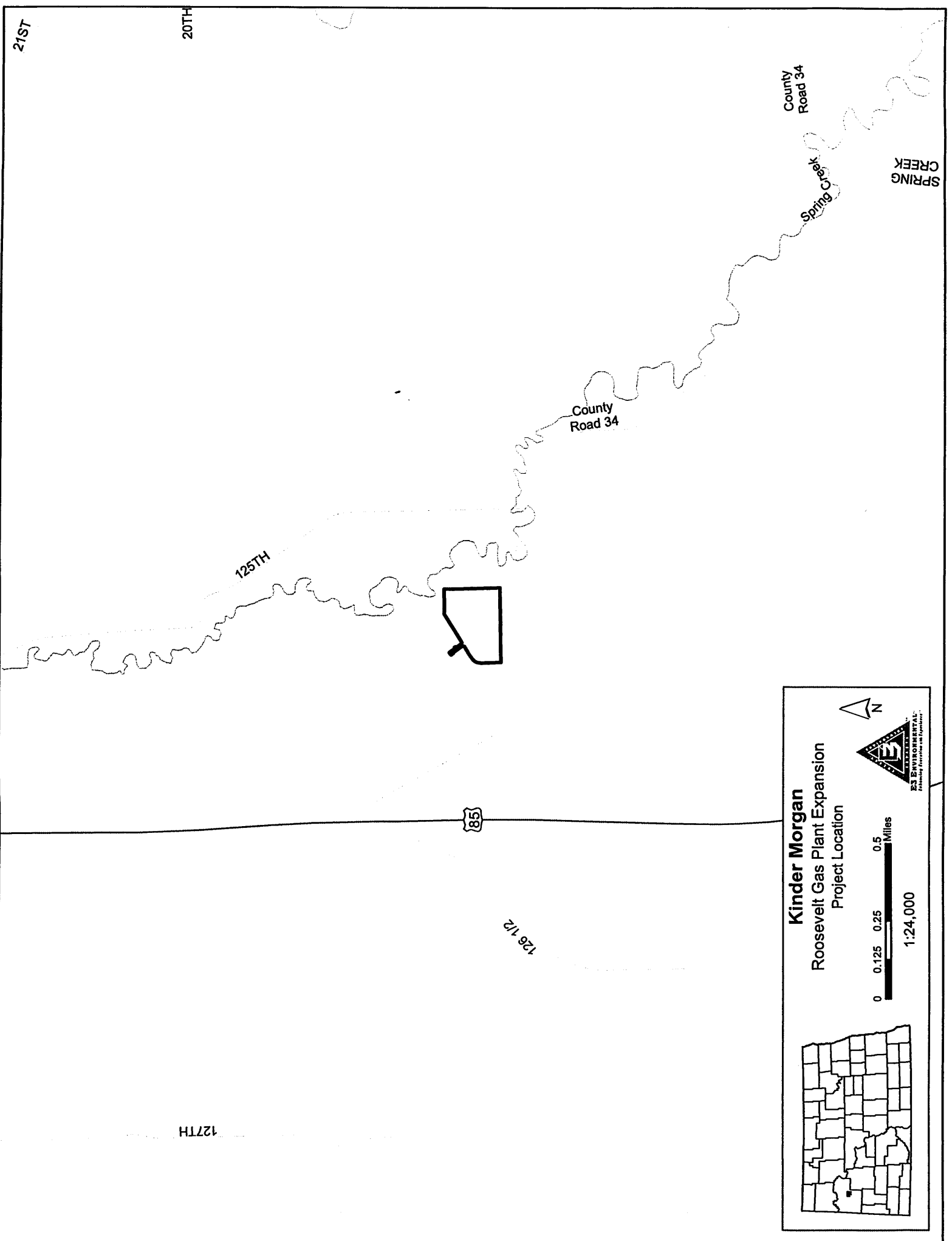


