The undersigned, Frederick J. Devereux, being first duly sworn on oath, does hereby state as follows:

1. I serve as Regional President for AT&T Mobility LLC ("Company"), and its subsidiary New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("New Cingular"). My business address is 208 S AKARD ST, Room 832, Dallas, Texas 75202.
2. In my capacity as Regional President, I am an authorized representative of the Company and its subsidiary licensees and am authorized to execute this certification on behalf of New Cingular.
3. New Cingular has been designated as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") for the purpose of qualifying to obtain all available federal universal service support including, but not limited to, support for rural, insular and high costs areas, and for low-income customers, In the Matter of the Application of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunication Carrier, Order, ND PSC Case No. PU-11-86 (July 13, 2011).
4. New Cingular files this affidavit pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") Order of May 23, 2001 in CC Docket 96-45, its Order of June 10, 2014 in WC Dockets 14-58, and 47 C.F.R. § 54.314, which requires certification to the FCC that all federal high-cost universal service support received by the carrier will only be used for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which support is intended.
5. In accordance with section 54.314(b) of the FCC's rules and section 254(e) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, New Cingular hereby certifies that it only used federal high-cost universal service support received during the preceding calendar year (2017) and will only use federal high-cost universal service support in the coming calendar year (2019) for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended.

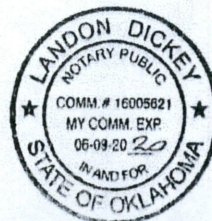
