Dear Landowner:

As you know, NextEra Energy Resources has been actively developing and advancing the Burke Wind project. The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the current progress of the project and next steps as we move forward with seeing this project become operational.

Current project progress:

- All county permits for the wind farm and transmission line in Burke and Mountrail Counties have been secured
- North Dakota Public Service Commission applications for both the wind farm and transmission line have been submitted

Most notably for this update is that NextEra Energy Resources has recently reduced the project size from 300 MW to 200 MW. This has resulted in the elimination of approximately 37 wind turbines within the project boundary. There are two main drivers of this project size reduction. In an effort to address environmental concerns with the project's proximity to Lostwood National Wildlife Refuge and concerns of some non-participating landowners, we have reduced our original project design. No doubt this will come as a disappointment to some of you who anticipated hosting one of the project's turbines. We will honor our commitments to all participating landowners and will continue to build a project that will benefit everyone in the local community with good jobs, additional tax revenue and economic growth. We thank you for your continued support for the project as it enters its final stages of the permitting process.

Burke Wind, LLC is in the process of submitting a revised North Dakota Public Service Commission application reflecting this reduction by Wednesday, November 7.
