- Wildlife will not be anywhere close to the towers and I am seeing a great increase in grouse and partridge numbers

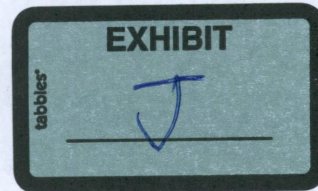
A tower is as tall as our State Capitol Building - 40 mile View Farm
