To Whom It May Concern:

Your company has asked Northwest Rural Water District (“District”) for permission to cross its water pipeline and right of way with another structure or facility (“Structure”) at a location or locations as described above and as shown on the attached one call schedule.

The District serves the public interest by operating its water pipeline for transporting treated water, under pressure. Damage to or breakage of the pipeline may result in injury to persons and damage to property. This is cause for constant concern on your part. Your business is also in the public interest, and we desire to cooperate with you, requesting your help in using your knowledge and experience to prevent damage to the pipeline. The District consents to your crossing in consideration of your agreement, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Before commencing work on said Structure, you shall provide 72 hrs days/hours written notice and consult with the District to discuss any issues associated with the crossing, and so that the District may have a representative present during the performance of the work.
2. You agree to pay for any modifications to the District pipeline which may be required (e.g. lowering, concrete caps, etc.). You further agree to pay for all damage to District property and to indemnify, protect and save the District harmless from any and all claims, demands, actions, and causes of action of whatsoever kind, for damage to or loss or destruction of property, loss of water, or for damage to or death of persons, caused by, or growing out of, or arising in connection with the construction, use, maintenance, removal or presence of the Structure, including indemnifying the District for any contamination, any clean-up or any environmental claims or actions resulting from your activities.

3. Work done by or for you shall be performed in a workmanlike manner in accordance with good engineering standards, due regard being given to the nature and purpose of the District's pipeline. You shall install such safety devices, and shall take such safety, protective, and precautionary measures, including protective devices, as required by governmental authority, or as the District shall reasonably require to protect the District's property and for the safety and protection of persons and property. You must comply with all laws according to the ND Century Code 49.23-06.
4. If you install said Structure above the District's pipeline, whether above or below the surface of the ground, and if in connection with the District's operations it becomes necessary for such Structure to be moved, relocated, raised or lowered, then upon written request of the District, you shall promptly cause such work to be done at your sole expense, it being understood that the District shall make reasonable effort to carry on its operations in such manner as to obviate any such request.
5. Trenches exposing the water pipeline can expose a maximum of 5 feet unless otherwise approved by the District. All crossings must be at a 90 degree angle unless otherwise approved by the District. A representative of the District must be present during digging and burying of pipe. If bedding is disturbed, the water pipeline must be sand bedded when buried. The water pipeline may only be exposed for a maximum of 48 hours (less if weather requires) unless otherwise approved by the District. All crossings must be a minimum of 2 feet below the water pipeline unless otherwise approved by the District. Work requiring attendance by District personnel supervision must be performed during normal working hours, Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm or you will be billed hourly for District personnel to be on site with a minimum of 2 hours. No weekend or holiday work will be allowed without prior approval.
6. Your company is liable for any representation that is misleading, proves to be untrue or is not fulfilled.
7. Any exceptions to any of the above conditions must be in writing and approved by the District.
8. If the District's lines are cut, all repairs will be paid for by the company and the water will be restored to the customers as soon as possible. If payments are not made, the District will pursue legal action.

This is not a grant from the District to you of an easement or permission to enter said land. You must obtain such authority from the landowner. The purpose of this Crossing Permit is to witness the District's consent to the Structure insofar as prior rights of the District are concerned.

This Crossing Permit is submitted in duplicate. Please witness your agreement hereto by signing in the space provided below, and be a returning a fully signed copy to Williams Rural Water District.

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

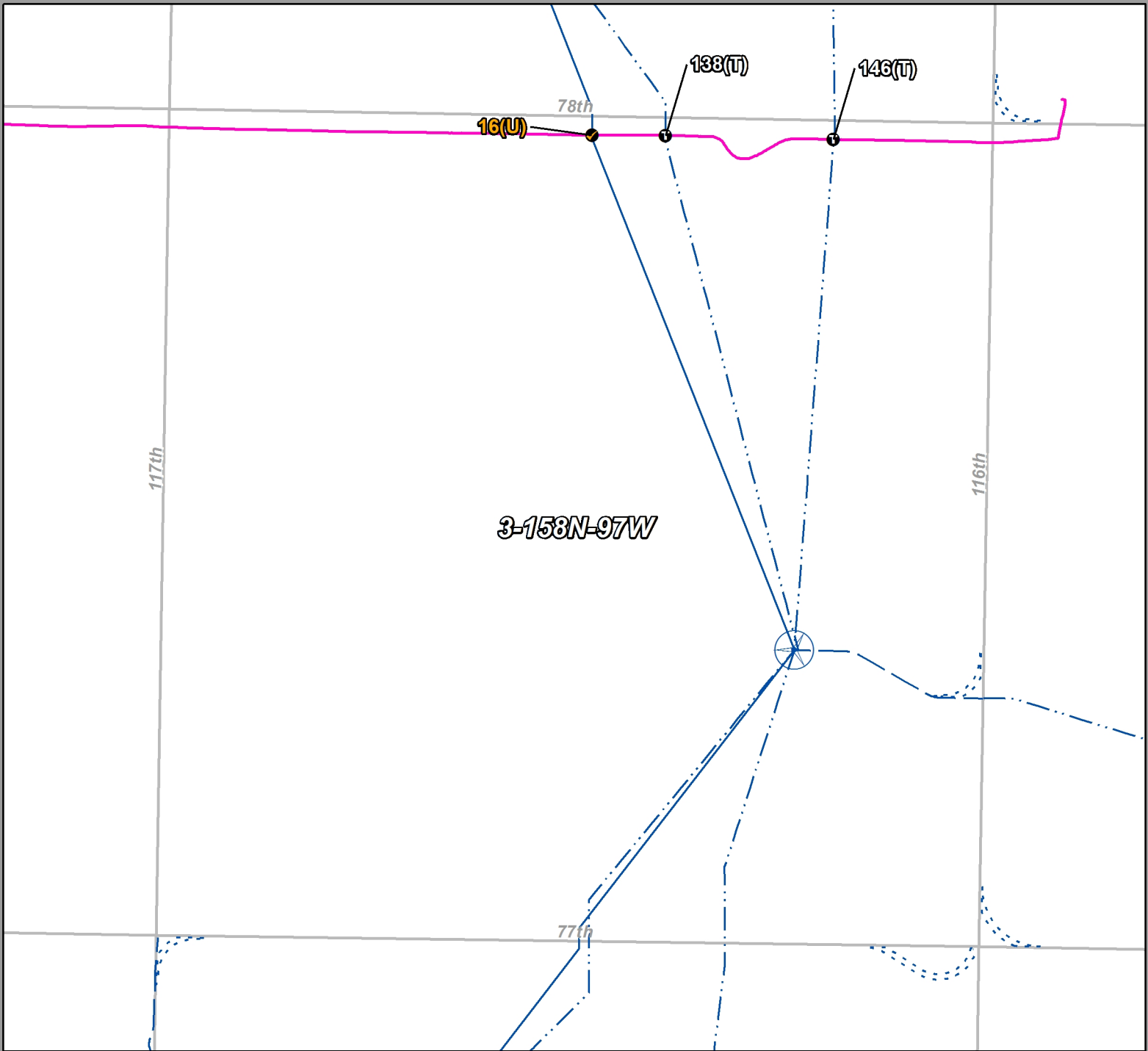

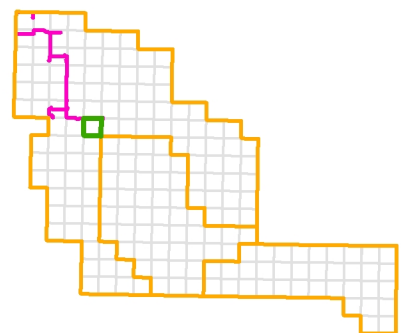
Crossing Plan
