

SHADOW FLICKER ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Aurora Wind Project, LLC intends to construct the Aurora Wind Project ("Project") to be located in Williams County, North Dakota. A portion of the Project may be located on or near your property, described as follows:

Township 158 North, Range 97 West of the 5th P.M.
Section 3: SE¼

(the "Property").

The Project is a wind energy conversion facility, and consists of wind turbines and other associated components. A wind turbine's moving blades can cast a moving shadow on locations within a certain distance of a turbine. These moving shadows are called shadow flicker, and can be a temporary phenomenon experienced at nearby residences. Shadow flicker impacts are not regulated in applicable state or federal law. However, developers in North Dakota often set a goal of 30 hours per year or less for shadow flicker impacts at inhabited residences. Operation of the Project may result in shadow flicker impacts that exceed 30 hours per year at an inhabited residence located on your Property.

By signing this waiver, you, as the owner of the inhabited residence on the Property, acknowledge and confirm that: (1) you understand operation of the Project may result in shadow flicker levels that exceed 30 hours per year at your residence; and (2) you have no objection to the construction and operation of the Project.
