Dear Executive Secretary:

Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless (“Telrite”) received the North Dakota Public Service Commission’s (“PSC”) letter, dated November 30, 2018 (the “November letter”). The November letter instructed Telrite to review a list of 27 customers that did not pass the North Dakota Human Service database dip. The PSC requested Telrite review the PSC’s list of 27 subscribers against Telrite’s active list of subscribers to determine if these 27 are qualified for Lifeline service and if not to remove them from Lifeline service.

Telrite has reviewed each of the 27 customers. From that list, 20 had been disconnected. The remaining 7 were found to be eligible under different programs other than Medical Assistance or SNAP and remain active.
