Liberty Resources II, LLC acknowledges that this recent line connection was not registered, and this was an oversight by Liberty.

As indicated by Whiting, this line is inactive and was not in service during the time in question. Liberty was forced to shut the gathering system down due it being over pressured when this tie in line section was initially place in service.

As the result of these events, Liberty has surveyed all the lines for the Glass Bluff Madison Unit (GBMU). The majority of these lines are 1980's vintage. We are in the process of registering all the lines within GBMU. I will communicate back to you when this has been completed.

Please also note that Liberty had personnel changes during this time which contributed to this failure to register the tie in line.
