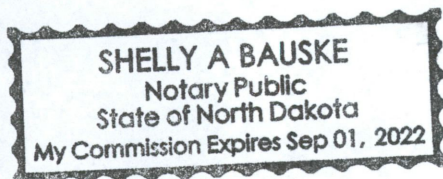


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 20, 2018

On November 1, 2018, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU), a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc., filed a change to its Transmission Cost Adjustment (TCA) tariff and TCA rates to reflect updated electric transmission revenues and costs.

The effect of the rate change on the bill for a residential customer using 894 kWh per month is a decrease of \$0.69 per month or \$8.28 per year compared with the existing TCA rate.

The issues to consider in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by January 3, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.


