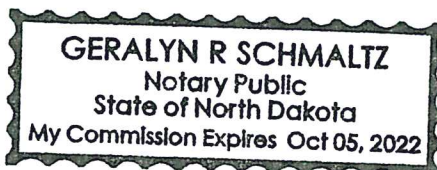


[¶ 3] FURTHER, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any claim must be filed within forty-five (45) days after the final publication of this notice.

[¶ 4] FURTHER, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any outstanding receiptholder or credit-sale contract claimant filing a claim with the Public Service Commission shall include receipts, contracts, or any other evidence of the claim as required by the Commission to enable the Commission to determine the validity of the claim. This could include unsatisfied grain warehouse receipts, scale tickets, dishonored checks, any related contracts, or other memoranda given by the public warehouseman for, or as evidence of, the receipt, storage, or sale of grain.

[¶ 5] FURTHER, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that unless a claim is filed with the Public Service Commission within the time specified, the Commission is relieved of further duty or action on behalf of the receiptholder or credit-sale contract claimant and the receiptholder or credit-sale contract claimant may be barred from payment for any amount due.

[¶ 6] FURTHER, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that outstanding receiptholders and credit-sale contract claimants are not parties to the insolvency action unless admitted by the Court upon a motion for intervention.


[¶ 2] It appears from the record that Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain is insolvent under North Dakota Century Code chapter 60-04 as of a date on or before November 14, 2018, and that it is in the best interest of potential claimants and the parties to this proceeding that a trustee be appointed.

ORDER

[¶ 3] **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** on the Application and Motion of the Public Service Commission by and through its attorney, the Public Service Commission is appointed trustee of the trust fund provided by North Dakota Century Code chapter 60-04 for the purpose of marshalling all trust assets of the insolvent Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain, in the manner provided by law.

**EX PARTE ORDER
TO PRESERVE TRUST
ASSETS**

[¶ 1] The Public Service Commission has petitioned the Court for appointment as Trustee of Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain, under North Dakota Century Code chapter 60-04, to join sureties, and for an *Ex Parte* Order to Protect Trust Assets. Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain, license address of 2373 65 1/2 St. NE, Rugby, ND 58368, operates licensed grain warehouses at Tunbridge and Rohrville, North Dakota, under North Dakota Century Code chapters 60-02 and 60-04.

[¶ 2] It appears from the record that Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain, is insolvent under North Dakota Century Code chapter 60-04, and that it is in the best interest of the claimants and the parties to this proceeding that an *ex parte* order be issued by this

Court to preserve and protect the potential assets of the trust fund until the Court issues its order granting or denying the application.


[¶ 3] North Dakota Century Code section 60-04-03.1 provides that the trust fund must consist of the following:

1. The grain in the warehouse of the insolvent warehouseman or the proceeds as obtained through the sale of such grain.
2. The proceeds, including accounts receivable, from any grain sold from the time of the filing of the claim that precipitated an insolvency until the commission is appointed trustee.
3. The proceeds of insurance policies upon grain destroyed in the elevator.
4. The claims for relief, and proceeds therefrom, for damages upon any bond given by the warehouseman to ensure faithful performance of the duties of a warehouseman.
5. The claim for relief, and proceeds therefrom, for the conversion of any grain stored in the warehouse.
6. Unencumbered accounts receivable for grain sold prior to the filing of the claim that precipitated an insolvency.
7. Unencumbered equity in grain hedging accounts.
8. Unencumbered grain product assets.

ORDER

[¶ 4] **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that Hunter Hanson d/b/a NoDak Grain, preserve and protect any trust assets, and is prohibited from selling, transferring, misappropriating, or removing potential assets of the trust fund as provided in North Dakota Century Code chapter 60-04, until the Court issues its order granting or denying the application for appointment of the Public Service Commission as Trustee of the trust fund in this proceeding.
