CASS COUNTY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE (CCEC) AND OTP HAVE AN UNOFFICIAL SERVICE TERRITORY AGREEMENT IN THIS AREA FOR OTP TO SERVE THE LOAD. I HAVE CONTACTED DONNIE BAASCH, CCEC, TO DISCUSS THE PROJECT AND CCEC HAS GIVEN PERMISSION TO PROCEED WITH SERVING THE LOAD. OTP WOULD INSTALL APPROXIMATELY 2,235 OF UNDERGROUND CABLE TO THE SITE.
