**Happy New Year!** Now that that holiday season has passed, it's time to (quickly) get back in the mindset of the next legislative session, which starts tomorrow morning.

Legislative Council has done a great job at prepping their website for session, including entering all of the pre-filed legislative bills. These pre-filed bills, and lots of other legislative information, is publicly available at <https://www.legis.nd.gov/assembly/66-2019/regular>. I encourage you to take a look and re-familiarize yourself with where to find certain information as that knowledge will come in handy over the next few months!

As we've done in the past, our office has reviewed all of the pre-filed bills and started a tracking list titled "HRMS Tracking List". We'll use this list to track bills of HR relevance and share that information with you on a weekly basis – during both the weekly "HR Contacts" meetings and followed-up by an email recap. There are four bills on our tracking list that have hearings this Friday. They are:
