See below summary of a lost time incident that occurred on June 11th, 2019, on the ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. Demicks Lake Pipeline (Case No. PU-18-399):

On Tuesday, June 11th, 2019, a contractor employee was prepping a mainline pipe bevel with a grinder. The grinder kicked sideways impacting the employee's right index knuckle penetrating the glove and ultimately lacerating the skin. The employee was transported to the nearest medical facility for medical treatment where he received six (6) sutures to close the wound. At the time of the incident, the employee was wearing all the proper personal protection equipment (PPE) and the grinder guard was installed. This injury is anticipated to be a lost time event.
