On May 1, 2019, the Commission issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in PU-19-399. In accordance with Order Finding of Fact No. 21, Braun Intertec Corporation ("Braun Intertec") was engaged to conduct geotechnical evaluations on areas identified by the North Dakota Geological Survey ("NDGS") as having the potential for future slope instability located at approximate mile posts 38.1 and 47.2. The geotechnical evaluations for these locations determined that the proposed depth of horizontal directional drilling ("HDD") of the pipeline in these areas is sufficient, and construction may proceed as planned.

Enclosed for filing in the above-referenced matter, are eight copies of Braun Intertec's geotechnical evaluations for HDD sites located at miles posts 38.1 and 47.2. Reports for remaining areas identified by the NDGS as having the potential for future geologic instability will be filed under separate cover.
