On behalf of ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. ("ONEOK"), I am writing in response to your July 29, 2019 letter (Docket No. 105) regarding ONEOK's July 24, 2019 modification filing occurring along approximate mileposts 34.8 - 35 (Docket No. 104). Your letter states that the July 24 route modification appears to cross an unidentified delineated feature labeled n-18042d-115 on page 40 of the Delineated Features map set (Docket No. 40) and requests additional information. Point n-18042d-115 indicates that desktop data identified a potential wetland/waterbody feature in this location. The point is an indication the area was evaluated during field survey and a wetland/waterbody feature was not identified.
