Dear Mr. Kahl:

On behalf of Belle Fourche Pipeline Company (“Belle Fourche”) notice is hereby provided that Belle Fourche intends to amend the Consolidated Application for Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit (“Consolidated Application”), filed on December 17, 2018 as Docket No. 1 in Case No. PU-18-405, for the conversion of an existing 18-mile, six-inch crude oil pipeline from a gathering to transmission function (the “Project”) which is located in Dunn, Stark, and Billings Counties.

Belle Fourche intends to decommission a 14-mile segment of the Project, which extends from the Skunk Hill Station and terminates at the Dickinson Station, and to withdraw this segment of the Project from the Consolidated Application. The amended Project route will consist of the approximate four remaining miles of the Project that extends from Dickinson Station south to Dakota Prairie Refining. Belle Fourche is currently in the process of completing an amendment to the Consolidated Application and Belle Fourche anticipates filing this amendment within the next 30 days, or sooner.

Commission counsel and staff were notified of the forthcoming amendment, and this notice is filed in accordance with staff’s request.
