

On January 24, 2020, Belle Fourche filed a Notice of Intent to Amend its Consolidated Application for Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit filed as Docket No. 1 in PU-18-405 ("Original Application") for the conversion of an existing 18-mile 6-inch crude oil gathering pipeline located in Dunn, Stark and Billings Counties, North Dakota. As discussed in more detail within its Amended Application, Belle Fourche withdraws the 14-mile segment of the originally proposed project located in Billings and Dunn Counties which extended from the Skunk Hill Pump Station to the Dickinson Station. The enclosed Amended Application pertains to the remaining 4-miles of the existing pipeline located in Stark County, North Dakota.
