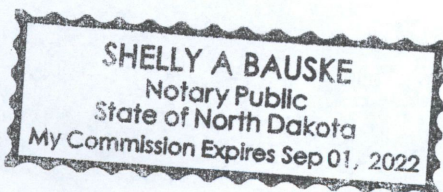


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

December 3, 2019

On December 28, 2018, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (MDU) filed for Commission approval a negotiated service agreement with American Colloid Company (ACC) for interruptible industrial electric power at ACC's Gascoyne, North Dakota facility. On November 15, 2019, MDU filed a restated electric service agreement with ACC.

The issue to be considered in this matter is whether the restated electric service agreement is just and reasonable and should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by January 10, 2020.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
