NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

June 12, 2019

On December 28, 2018, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (MDU) filed Amendment No. 2 Electric Service Agreement between Sabin Metals West Corporation. (Sabin Metals) and MDU. Amendment No. 2 provides for continued sale of all firm electric power required by Sabin Metals at a rate other than the applicable General Electric Service Rate 30.

On February 12, 2019 MDU filed a revision to Amendment No. 2 rates set forth in Exhibit A1 to Amendment No. 2.


On May 7, 2019, MDU filed a Settlement Agreement negotiated with Public Service Commission Advocacy Staff, intended to resolve all outstanding issues between the settling parties in this case. Under the Settlement Agreement MDU will charge Amendment No. 2 rates to Sabin Metals until MDU's next general rate case when a new study of costs to serve Sabin Metals will be completed.

The issue to be considered in this matter is whether the Settlement Agreement is just and reasonable and should be approved.



Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by July 22, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
