**ORDER ADMITTING LATE-FILED EXHIBITS**

**OAH FILE Nos. 20190068**

The hearing in this matter was held on June 17, 2019. At the hearing, Exhibits 1 through 48 were admitted into the record. The parties also agreed at the hearing that Ruso Wind Partners, LLC (Ruso Wind) would file nine additional exhibits after the hearing. The late-filed exhibits were admitted into the record and pre-numbered Exhibits 49 through 57. Late-filed Exhibits 49 through 57 were filed on August 9, 2019.

On August 15, 2019, Ruso Wind filed a Motion to Consider Post-Hearing Filings. The proposed late-filed documents include Exhibit 58 - Northern Long-eared Bat Mist Netting Surveys Report and Exhibit 59 – update on the status of Ruso Wind’s interconnection request in the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.’s queue. There was no objection to admitting Exhibits 58 and 59.

On September 3, 2019, the Laborers District Council of Minnesota & North Dakota (LIUNA) filed a Motion to Consider Post-Hearing Filing. LIUNA is requesting a legal memorandum from the Braaten Law Firm be admitted as late-filed Exhibit 60. The memorandum addresses the legal authority to consider and require reporting on the use of local labor in the construction of the proposed project. LIUNA also submitted its own proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order. The PSC takes no position on LIUNA’s motion. Ruso Wind does not object to the motion but requests an opportunity to respond to the

information and evidence in proposed Late-filed Exhibit 60 and the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Late-filed Exhibits 58 and 59 offered by Ruso Wind Partners, LLC are accepted into the record.
2. Late-filed Exhibit 60 offered by Laborers District Council of Minnesota & North Dakota is accepted into the record.
3. Ruso Wind Partners shall have 10 business days from the date of service of this Order to file a response to Exhibit 60 and the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order filed by Laborers District Council of Minnesota & North Dakota.


