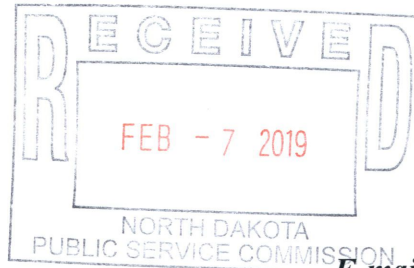

Section A: Energy Conversion Facility

The Burke County Wind Energy Center (or the “Project”) is a proposed wind project located in Burke County, North Dakota. As proposed, the Project will have a nameplate capacity of 200 megawatts (“MW”) consisting of up to 76 wind turbines, using General Electric (“GE”) 2.72 MW wind turbine generators and 1.715 MW wind turbine generators. Additional facilities associated with the Project include access roads, one permanent meteorological evaluation tower (“MET”), a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisitions (“SCADA”) system, transformers, an operations and maintenance (“O&M”) building, and a proposed project substation, a construction laydown area, and a batch plant.

Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2019, and commercial operation is scheduled for December 2019. The Project is not expected to retire in the next ten years.

The Project includes an electrical collection system that will transport energy from 76 turbine feeders to the wind project collection substation. From this collection substation, the Project will interconnect to the electrical transmission grid through an approximately 37-mile 345 kilovolt ("kV") overhead generation tie line, which will begin at the south-central edge of the Project area and tie into the existing Tande Substation owned by Basin Electric Power Cooperate ("Basin").




