Subject: Close out of Contract Number AM-813-19 for 2019 Williams County Road 9 Phase 7 and Noonan Material Testing AML Project

On June 12, 2019, the Commission entered into Contract No. AM-813-19 with Material Testing Services, LLC for the associated grout testing and other services for the 2019 Williams County Road 9 Phase 7 and Noonan Material Testing AML Project. This project involved drilling to locate underground mine voids in Divide County and the injection of pressurized grout into mine voids near structures in Williams County. Chris Brown and James Thornburg and Joan Breiner supervised this project and the work of the contractor.

The original contract with Material Testing Services, LLC for related services was in the amount of \$38,400. The AML Division had estimated that an on-site material tester would be needed for 375 hours and laboratory testing for 70 series (3 samples per series) of grout samples and three structural surveys. The final totals were 194.75 hours for the material tester, 59 series of samples and 3 structural surveys. The final cost was \$23,566 or 61.37% of the original contract. The Noonan portion of Contract AM-812-19 was not completed so some of Contract AM-813-19 was not completed.

All work is completed and the final invoice has been paid. We have received the Certification of Payment. The AML Division recommends Contract AM-813-19 be closed. Attached is a motion for the October 22 Commission Meeting.
