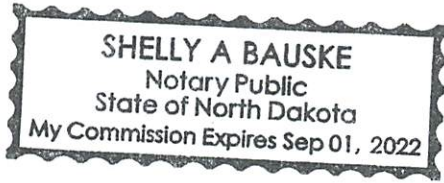

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

May 29, 2019

On March 15, 2019, Northern States Power Company (NSP) requested approval to use the North Dakota jurisdictional share of gains from the sale of two LP storage tanks, associated equipment and the real property upon which the facilities are located to partially offset the costs of remediating the site of a former manufactured gas plant (Case No. PU-15-514) in Fargo, North Dakota. NSP estimates the North Dakota jurisdictional share of financial gain is \$649,000.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether the North Dakota jurisdictional share of gains is just and reasonable.
2. Whether it is appropriate to offset costs for the Fargo manufactured gas plant with gains from the asset sale.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by July 8, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
