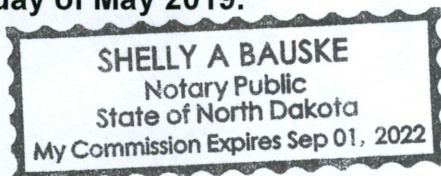

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

May 20, 2019

On June 8, 2011, in Case No. PU-08-932 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 23, enXco Development Corporation's (enXco) designating a site for its Merricourt Wind Project in Dickey and McIntosh Counties of North Dakota.

On May 3, 2019, in Case No. PU-19-144, EDF Renewable Development, Inc (EDF), formerly enXco, and Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed a joint application to transfer Certificate Number 23 from EDF to Otter Tail.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-19-144 are whether Otter Tail agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.


Those interested are invited to comment in writing on the application in Case No. PU-19-144. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by June 21, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
