
Dear Mr. Kahl:

On May 3, EDF Renewables Development, Inc. ("EDF") and Otter Tail Power Company ("OTP") filed a joint application to transfer the Second Amended Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 23 for the Merricourt Wind Project from EDF to OTP (conditioned and effective upon closing of the sale of the Merricourt Project to OTP by EDF and three of its affiliates under the Asset Purchase Agreement entered into on November 16, 2016). The Commission today approved the joint application.

EDF submitted the \$5,000 filing fee in connection with the joint application. Pursuant to Commission staff's request, this letter is to advise that any potential refund associated with unused portions of the filing fee should be refunded to EDF.
