This letter is provided to notify the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") that Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership ("Enbridge"), intends to replace a segment of its existing Line 3 Pipeline located in Pembina County, North Dakota ("Project") as part of its ongoing maintenance program. Since the Project is for maintenance of an existing pipeline, rather than construction of a new pipeline, prior notification to the Commission is not required under the North Dakota Energy Conversion and Transmission Facility Siting Act, N.D.C.C. Ch. 49-22.1 ("Siting Act"). However, because "construction" is broadly defined in N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3), Enbridge is submitting this letter and the enclosed Certification to ensure compliance with N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a).

As set forth in the Certification, Enbridge intends to replace an approximate 12.3 mile segment of its existing Line 3, a 34-inch pipeline, located entirely in Pembina County, North Dakota. Certification at ¶ 5. This replacement segment is part of Enbridge's existing Line 3 Pipeline, which extends approximately 1,031 miles between Hardisty, Alberta, Canada and Superior, Wisconsin. *Id.* at ¶ 3. Line 3 is a transmission facility which was original constructed in 1967 prior to enactment of the Siting Act (April 9, 1975), and is, therefore, granted a corridor width of 350 feet on either side of the centerline pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a)(1)(c). *Id.* at ¶ 4.


The Project will consist of installation of approximately 12.3 miles of new 36-inch pipe, a tie-over to tie the new pipe to the existing Line 3 Pipeline, and one new 36-inch valve. Certification at ¶ 5. A map depicting the Project is attached to the Certification as Exhibit A. The replaced portion of the existing Line 3 Pembina County Segment will be deactivated once the new segment is placed in service. *Id.* at ¶ 6. As set forth in the Certification, the Project complies with the requirements of N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a). *Id.* at ¶¶ 7-8.
